MVA TREASURER'S REPORT

There is about \$8,500 in checking, \$20,000 in savings, and \$870 in petty cash. Some money will be moved from checking to petty for the festival. For income, there's been some action with household memberships, a bronze business membership, sponsorship from the garden tour, summer festival for vendors, and rental of the info center. For expenses, there's rent, utilities, a special rider for our insurance policy for the festival, and summer festival expenses. If you have interest in using some of the grant funds, let us know. Our treasurer also has some homework: asked to create a list of what each grant is for and what the money remaining can be used towards.

WALKABILITY AUDITS GUEST SPEAKER

The Merion Village Block Watch is partnering with Columbus Public Health to do a walkability audit of the area. This is when neighbors get together to walk the neighborhood and identify any issues with walking in the neighborhood such as low hanging branches and cracked/bad sidewalks. They'll make a report that can be taken to city council to have anything addressed that 311 portal doesn't fix. There are 2 routes being considered for September 28th at an unknown time – north and south. Each route is about 2-2.5 miles long. There will be a training session on this process and then the walk will start. If many people show up, they can be split into 2 groups so both routes can be covered. If not, the other route will be covered at another time. Get the word out! More info coming soon.

How many people would be at the gym at once and at what times? Is it possible to list 8th instead of Jenkins as where to park for the business? What kind of gym will it be? Will there be classes or crossfit where many people are showing up at once?
